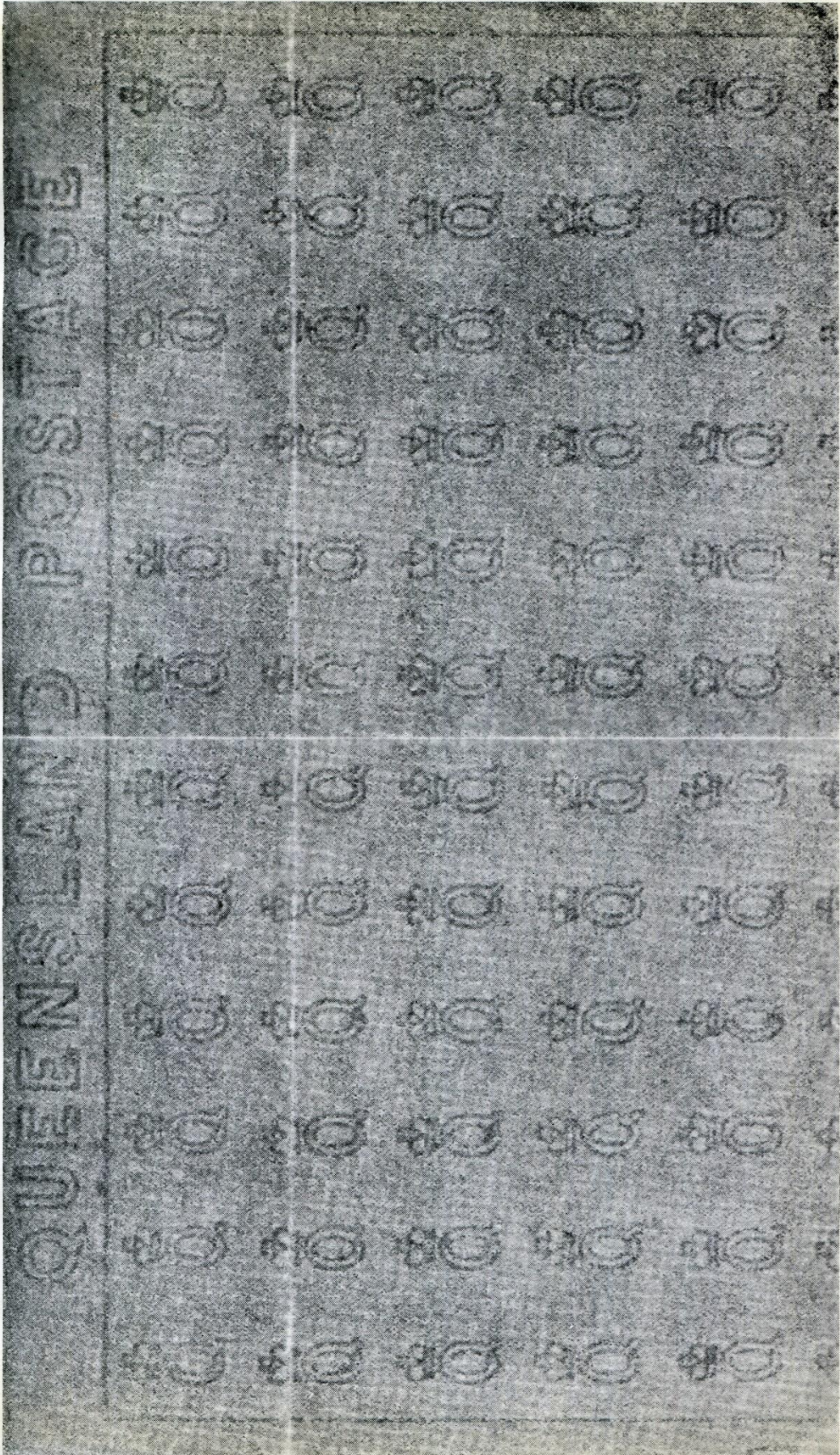

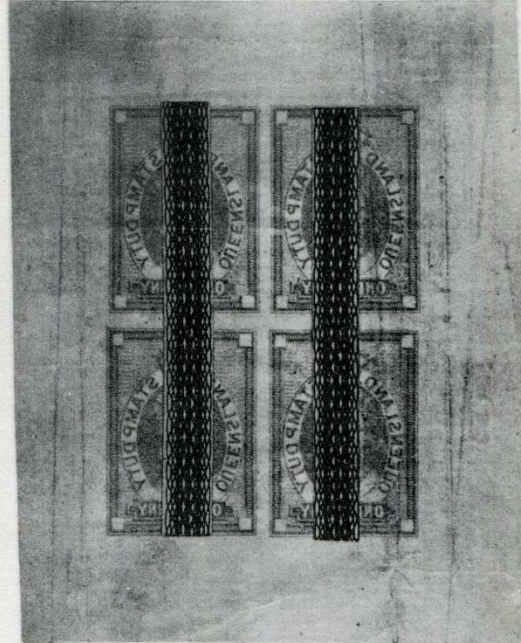

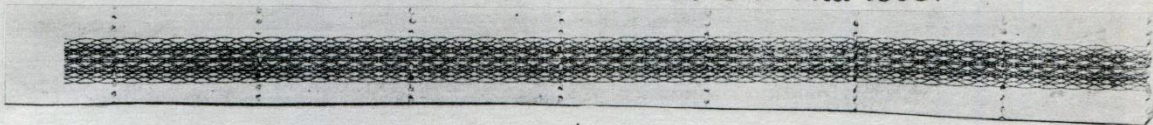

The Burelé Pattern used in 1872 and 1895.



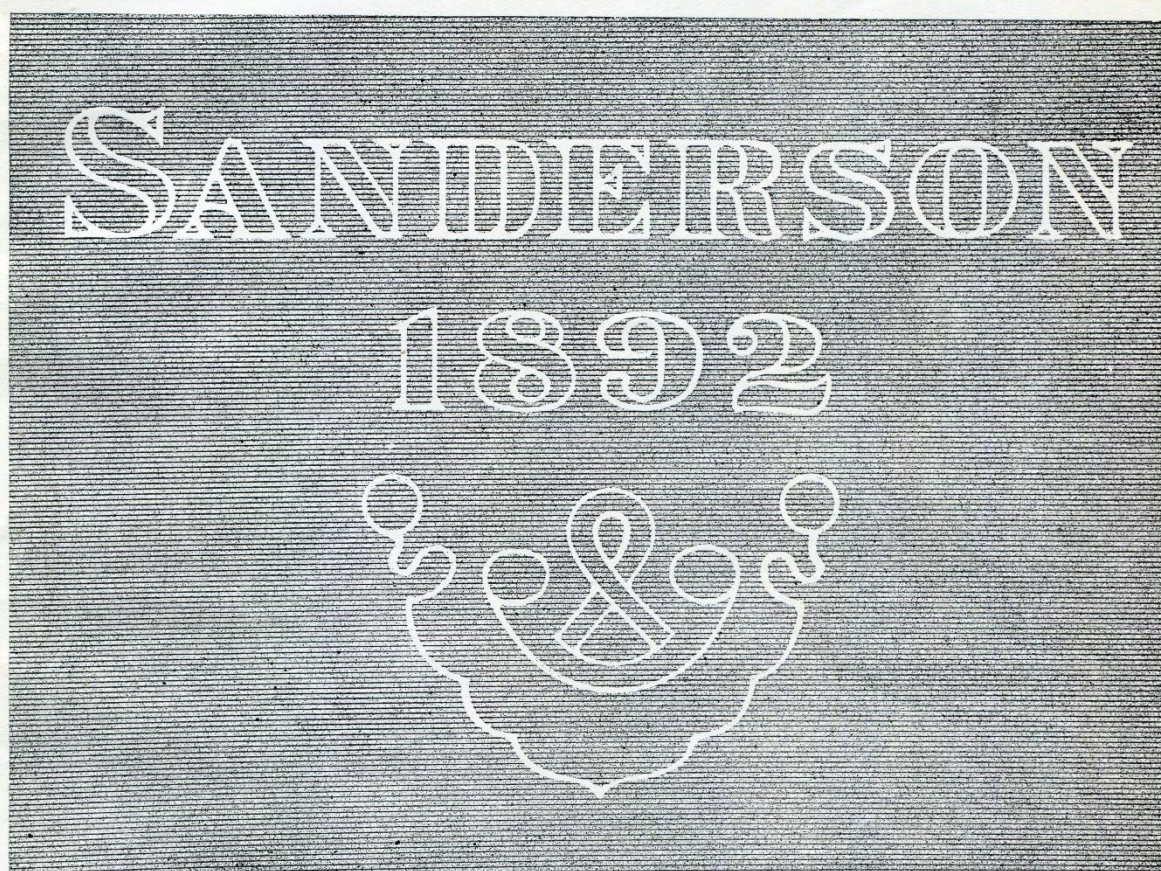

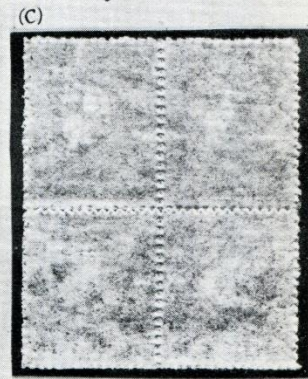

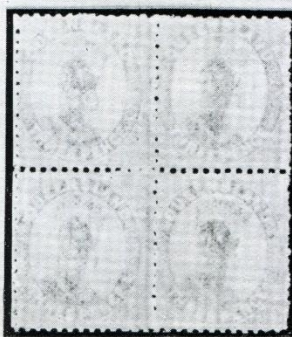

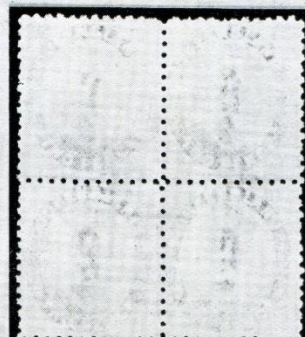

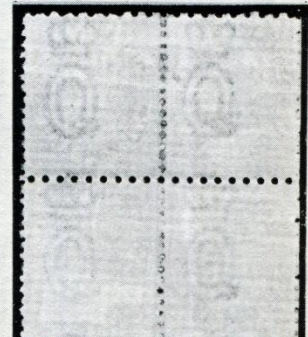

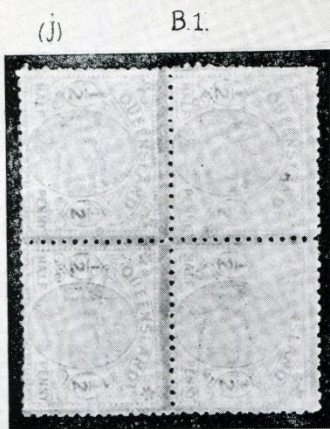

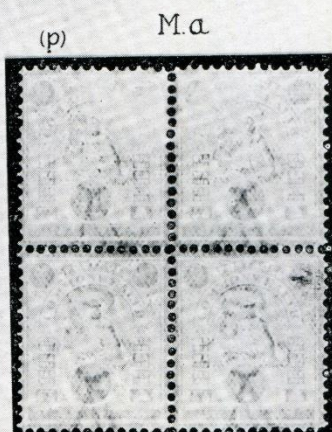

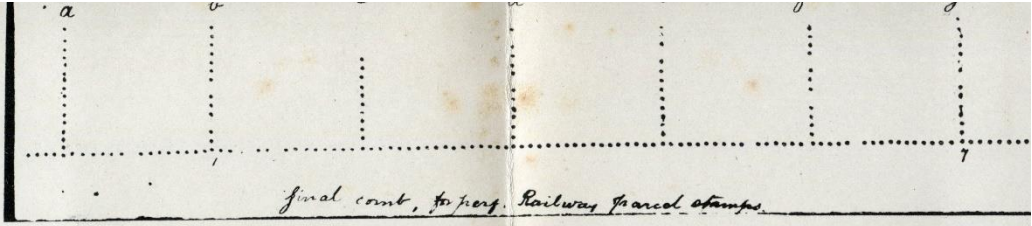

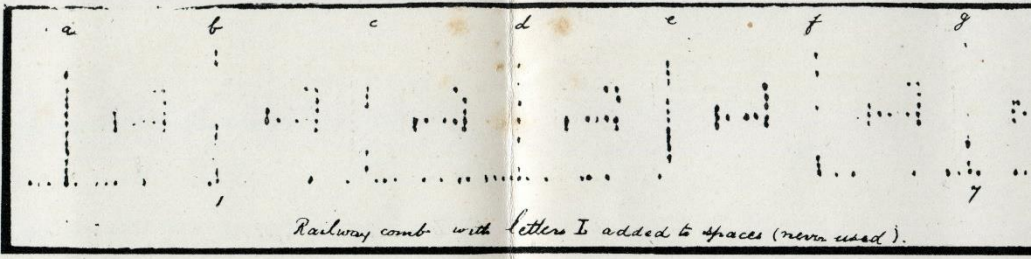

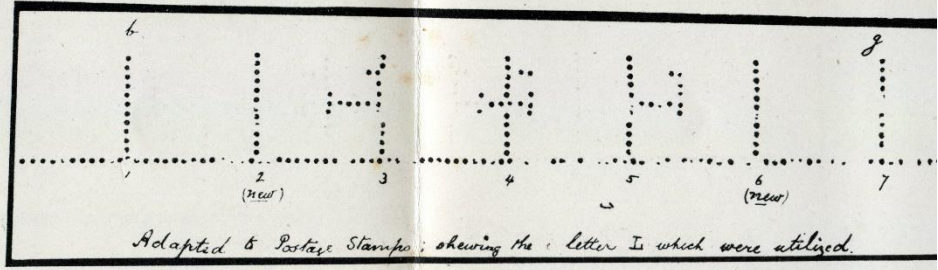

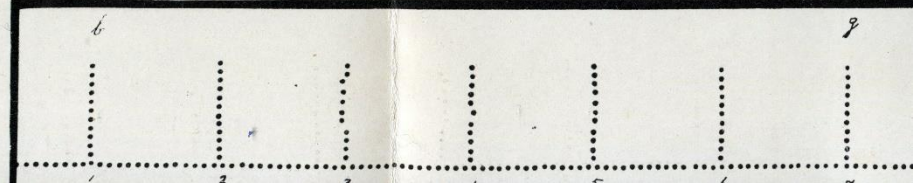
